2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of Blackberry, dark chocolate, leather and sweet toffee caramel. Background aromas of eucalypt leaf and cedar. Super complex aromas. The palate is a full rich mouthful of red wine, with loads of coffee/mocha characters, firm cabernet tannins and a well-balanced finish. a classic "best of both worlds" blend of Eden Valley and Barossa Valley Cabernet.

STYLE

True cool climate Cabernet Sauvignon; ripe dark fruits and fine tannins.

REGION

Sourced from our family's Corryton Burge vineyard in the Eden Valley where the cool microclimate is ideal for growing premium Cabernet Sauvignon.

VINTAGE SUMMARY

The 2019 vintage was characterised by a warm and dry growing period, resulting in one of the earliest vintages on record. While yields were low, ripening of grapes kept up with sugar development. Both colour and flavour this vintage are exceptional, with bold wines the result.

MATURATION

After completing malolactic fermentation in barrel the wine then remained in oak for a total of 20 months. 100% French oak, 30% of which was new.

CELLARING

Drinking best 10-15 years.
