TASTING NOTES

Ruby Red with purple hues. Confectionary, jubes, cherry, violets, lavender, and potpourri are the first aromas that jump out of the glass. Behind these primary aromas are hints of stalky complexity, subtle sherbet characters and the underlying aroma of musk. A fruit-driven aroma by design. The palate is all about the fruit, showcasing the cherry and musk flavours, with a balanced level of varietal chalky grenache tannins, however by no means a tannic wine. The finish is all fruit, soft and juicy, with just a hint of tannin to prop up the structure of the wine.

REGION

Sourced from a mix of family-owned and grower vineyards throughout central and southern Barossa including long-term growers like the Semmler family. Our family-owned vineyards are predominantly bush vine grown, including some of the oldest vines in the Barossa.

VINTAGE SUMMARY

2022 saw a cooler-than-average growing season that led to extended ripening conditions and retention of natural acidity. As a result, patience was required to wait for optimum harvest dates ensuring full flavour development and acid balance was reached. Patience was rewarded with outstanding flavours and varietal definition with exceptional quality across all white varietals.

MATURATION

Half the volume of this wine is matured in 2500 litres French Oak Foudres, with the rest spending 8-9 months in barrels of various ages.

Drink now - 5 years.
